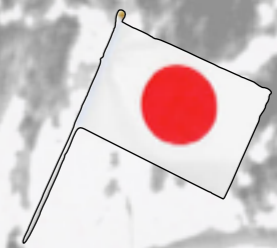

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# Many actions of the TYL

- ❖ **Support to TYL projects:**
  - ❖ Referees evaluate: **scientific quality** but also **collaboration quality** and **TYL added value**.
  - ❖ Increasing number of projects: **30 collaborative projects in 2019**.  
**New procedure on the French side:** support transferred only for actual travels to Japan.
- ❖ **Additional support obtained from French universities:**
  - ❖ Obtained so far: Strasbourg and Paris-Saclay.
  - ❖ You are welcome to help to negotiate with your university.
- ❖ **Organisation of the annual workshop, jointly with FKPPL.**
  - ❖ Next year in France, see following slides.
- ❖ **Support for Early stage researcher secondments:**
  - ❖ Allocation of per-diem support + flight tickets.
  - ❖ **Submit your application as arises** (on a 'first come, first served' basis).
  - ❖ Many student exchanges in JFY-2018: **3 Japan→France & 5 France→Japan** (3 paid directly by universities).
- ❖ **Joined PhD theses:**
  - ❖ On-going investigation.

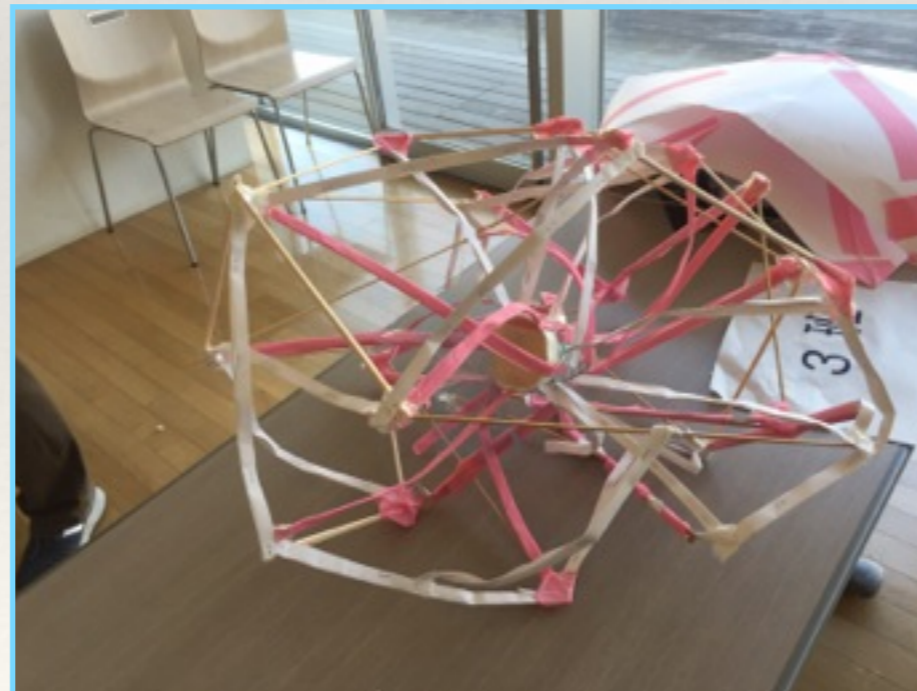
## Many actions of the TYL (cont'd)

- ❖ **Fostering of young researcher talents:**
  - ❖ **Sviatoslav Bilokin** was awarded the TYL Young Investigator Prize in 2019.
- ❖ **Fostering of female scientist careers:**
  - ❖ **Toshiko Yuasa Female Scientist Prize** was awarded in 2019 to **E. Kou** by Ochanomizu university.
  - ❖ **Rikejoshi Female High School Student camp** in April at KEK. With F. Marion (CNRS Medal 2017), Y. Motizuki (TY Prize 2016) and H. Tokoro.

Local organiser: Guillaume Batigne &co. (ALICE TYL project).

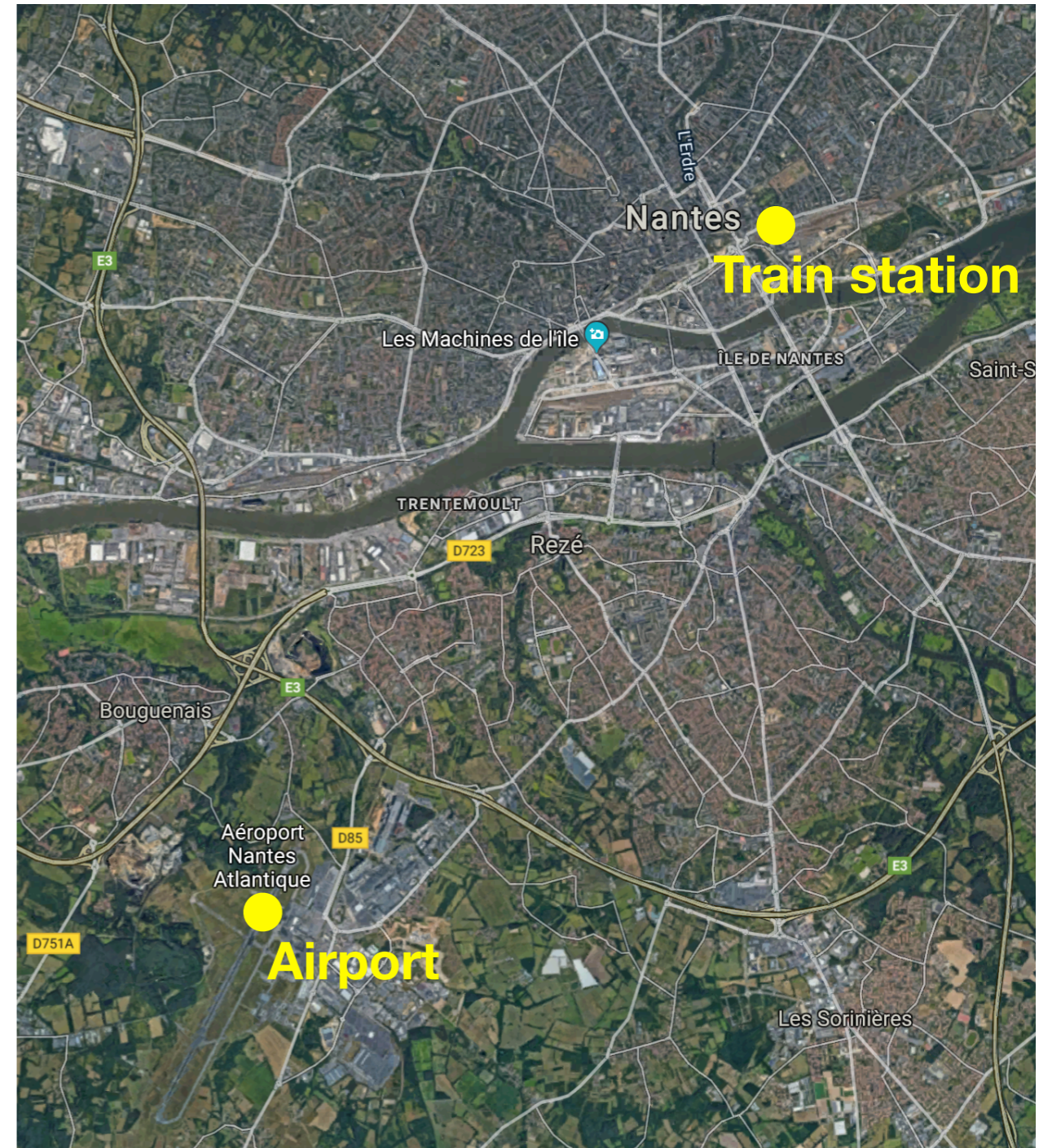


# Travelling to Nantes



From Paris:

- Frequent flights from Charles de Gaulle airport: 1h15
- Train: 2h15 from Montparnasse station (Paris)  
3h30 from Charles de Gaulle airport



Access to city center:

- Train station already in the city center
  - Airport:
    - Airport shuttle (30mn 8€)
    - Bus 48 + Tram 3 (45mn 1,50€)
- Frequency: bus every 20mn

Former capital of Brittany  
City of Anne de Bretagne (1477-1514)  
only woman to have been  
Queen of France twice  
Brittany part of the French kingdom  
after the death of Anne de Bretagne.



Located at 50km from the Atlantic ocean  
One of the main harbours on west coast  
of France (with Bordeaux) until mid-XX<sup>th</sup>  
century.

# Nantes: City of Culture

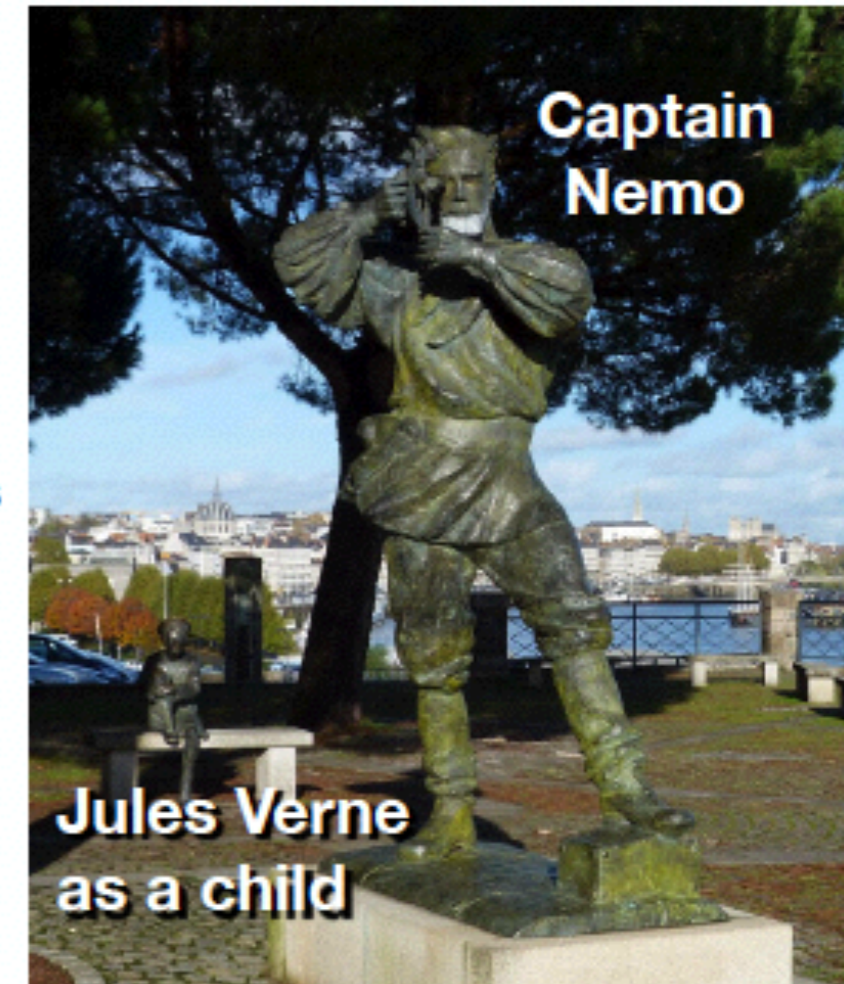
Home city of Jules Verne

Highly artistic city: a lot of concerts, exhibitions, etc. in and around Nantes



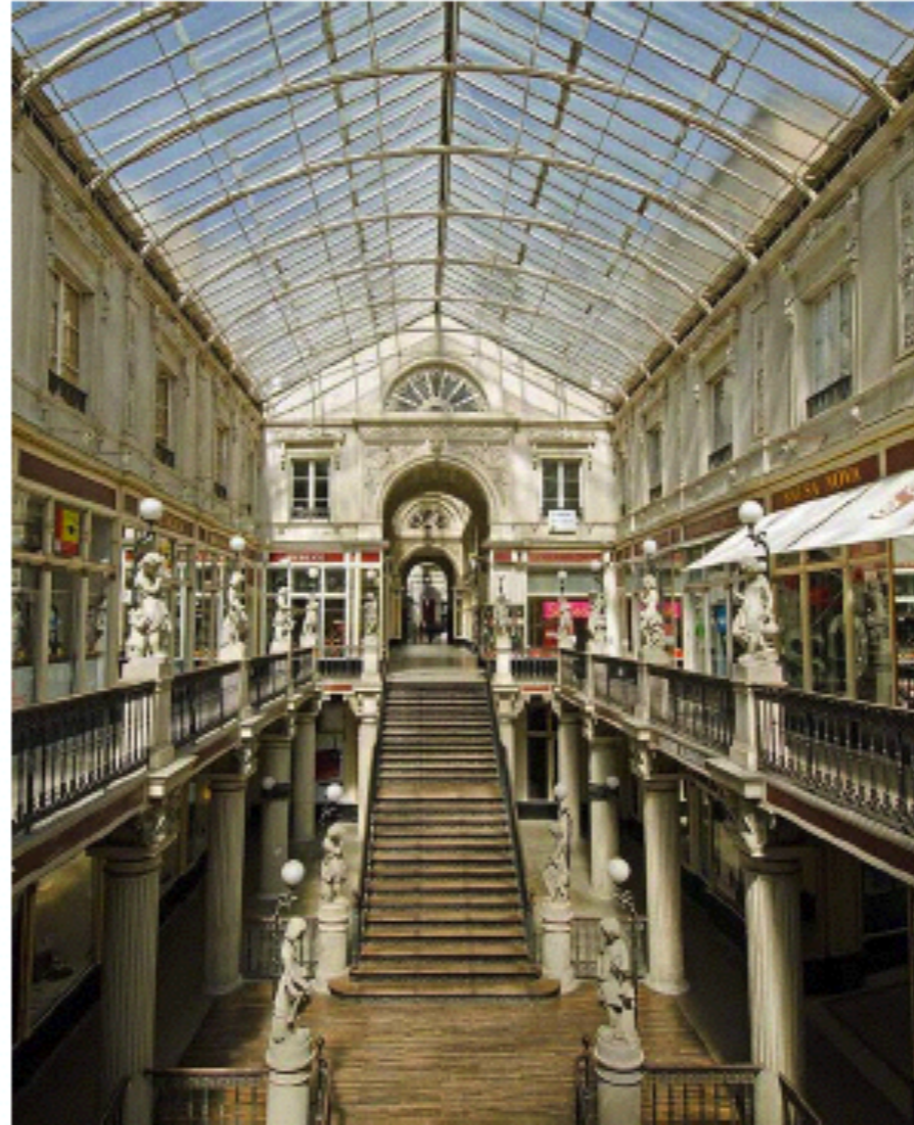
Modern Art installations
